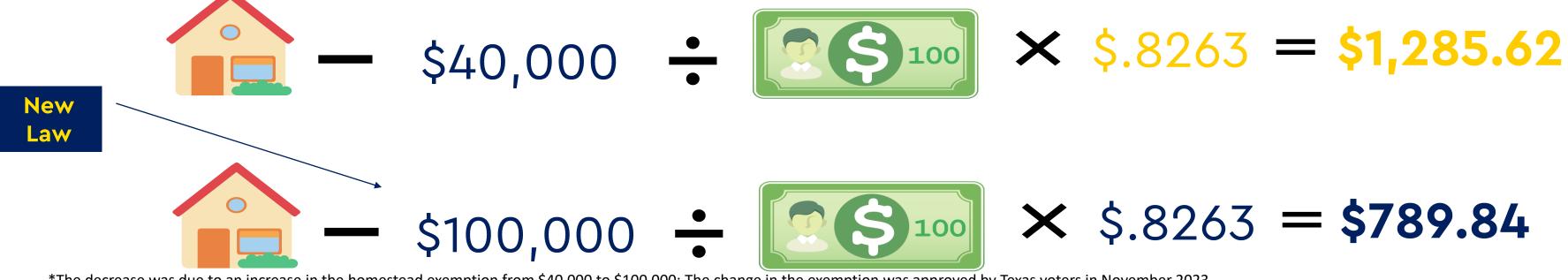


# PROPERTY VALUES

# Tax Rates - M&O



- The M&O Tax Rate is calculated by TEA; HB3 passed in 2019 to reduce school tax rates
- The M&O rate decreased from FY2023 \$1.0061 to FY2024 \$.8263
- Homestead exemptions protect a portion of their home's value from taxation, thus lowering their taxes. To qualify for the general residence homestead exemption an individual must own the property and use the property as their principal residence.
- The EPISD certified net taxable values for 2023 decreased by 5% to \$18 billion.\*
- The District can adopt the State rate or seek voter approval to set a higher M&O rate (4 cents higher)



<sup>\*</sup>The decrease was due to an increase in the homestead exemption from \$40,000 to \$100,000; The change in the exemption was approved by Texas voters in November 2023



# Tax Rates - 1&S



- The 2024 debt payments is \$57.1 million
- Homestead exemptions protect a portion of their home's value from taxation, thus lowering their taxes. To qualify for the general residence homestead exemption an individual must own the property and use the property as their principal residence.
- The I&S rate increased from FY2023 \$.3076 to FY2024 \$.3108



# Tax Rates



### Compression

Maintenance & Operations

Tax Compression was part of HB3 in 2019 - It does not impact overall funding; it impacts the balance of local and state funding. As local funding increases, State funding will decrease, tax compression is not supposed to affect the total.

Homestead Exemption: Increased from \$40,000 to \$100,000 in tax year 2023

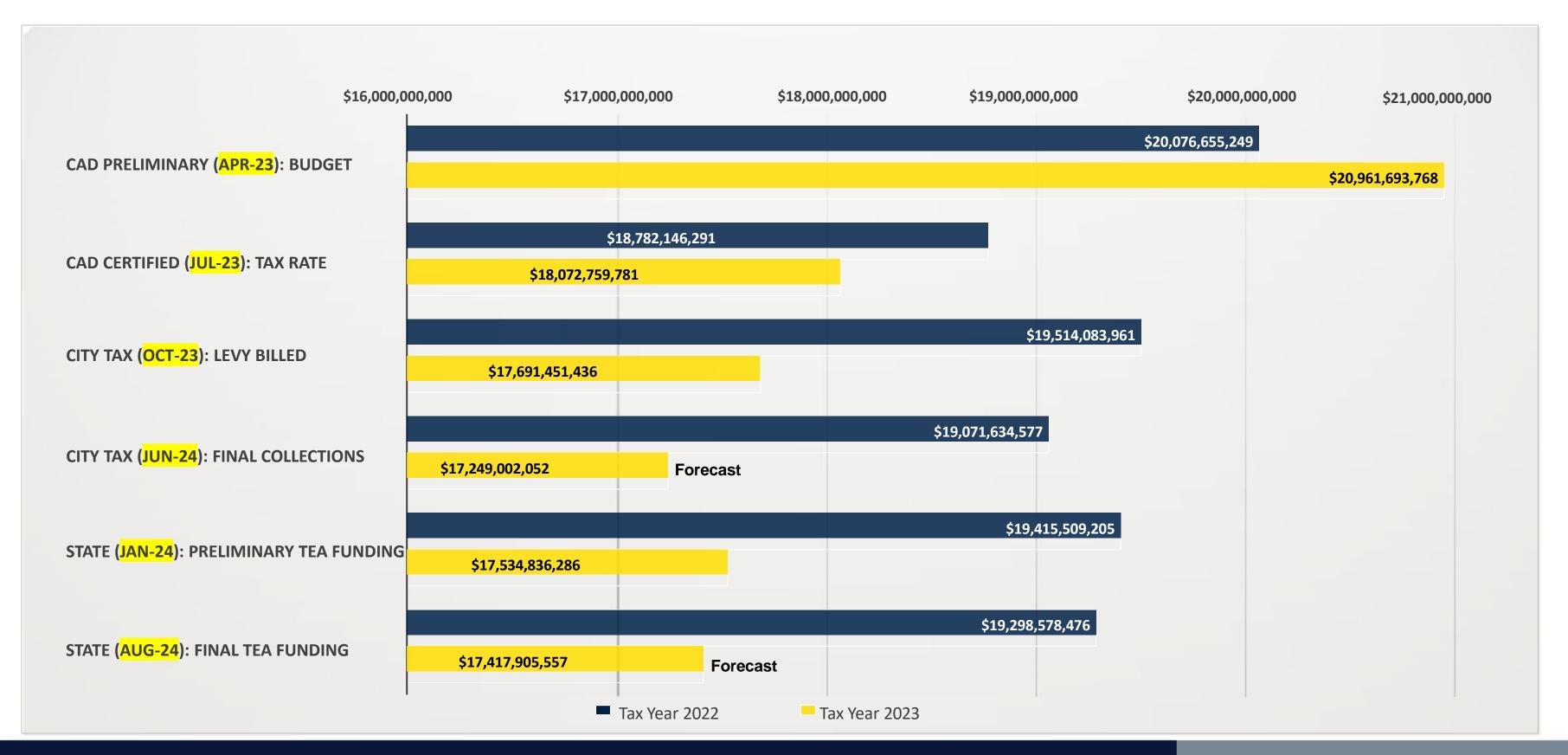

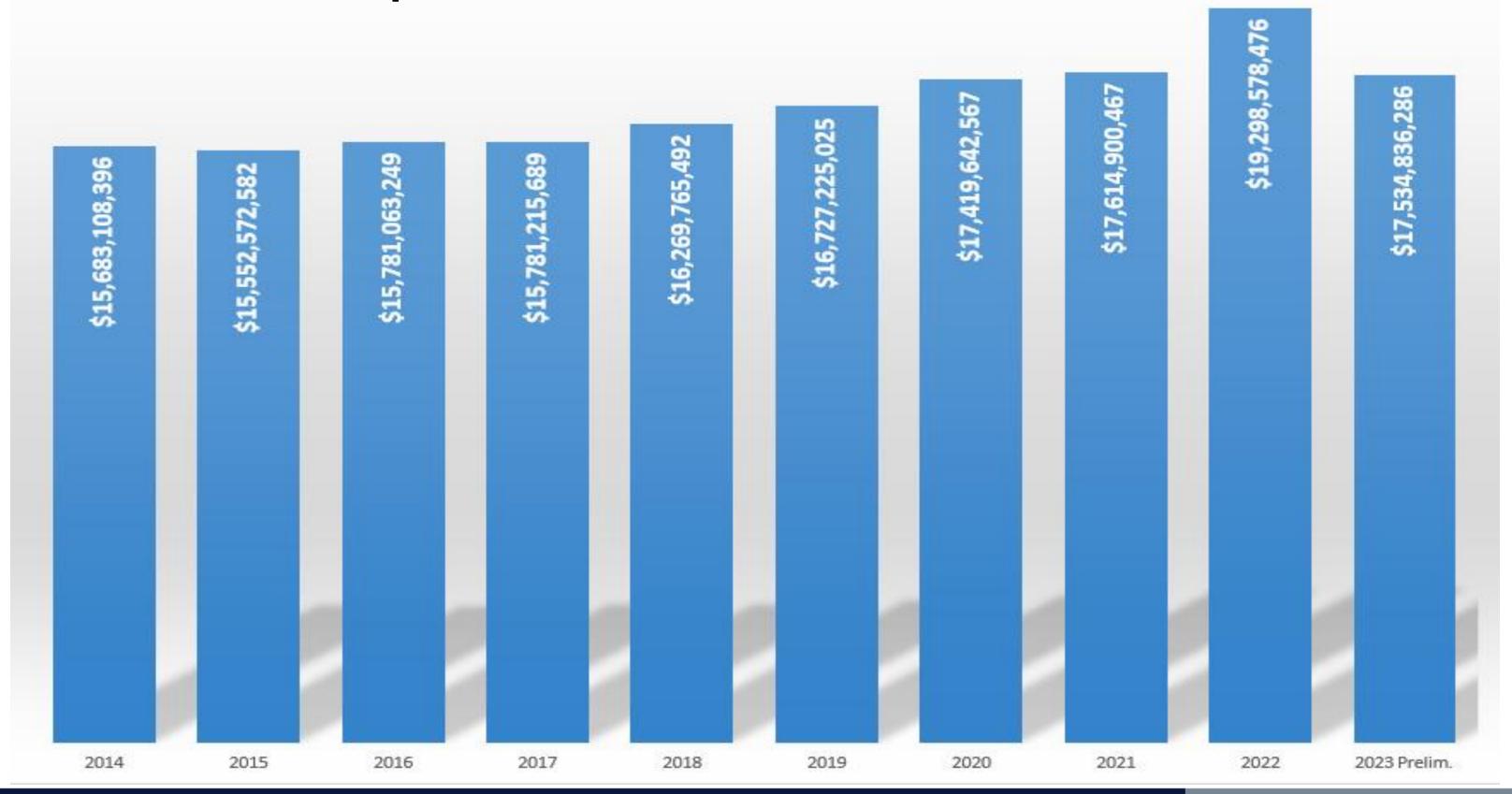

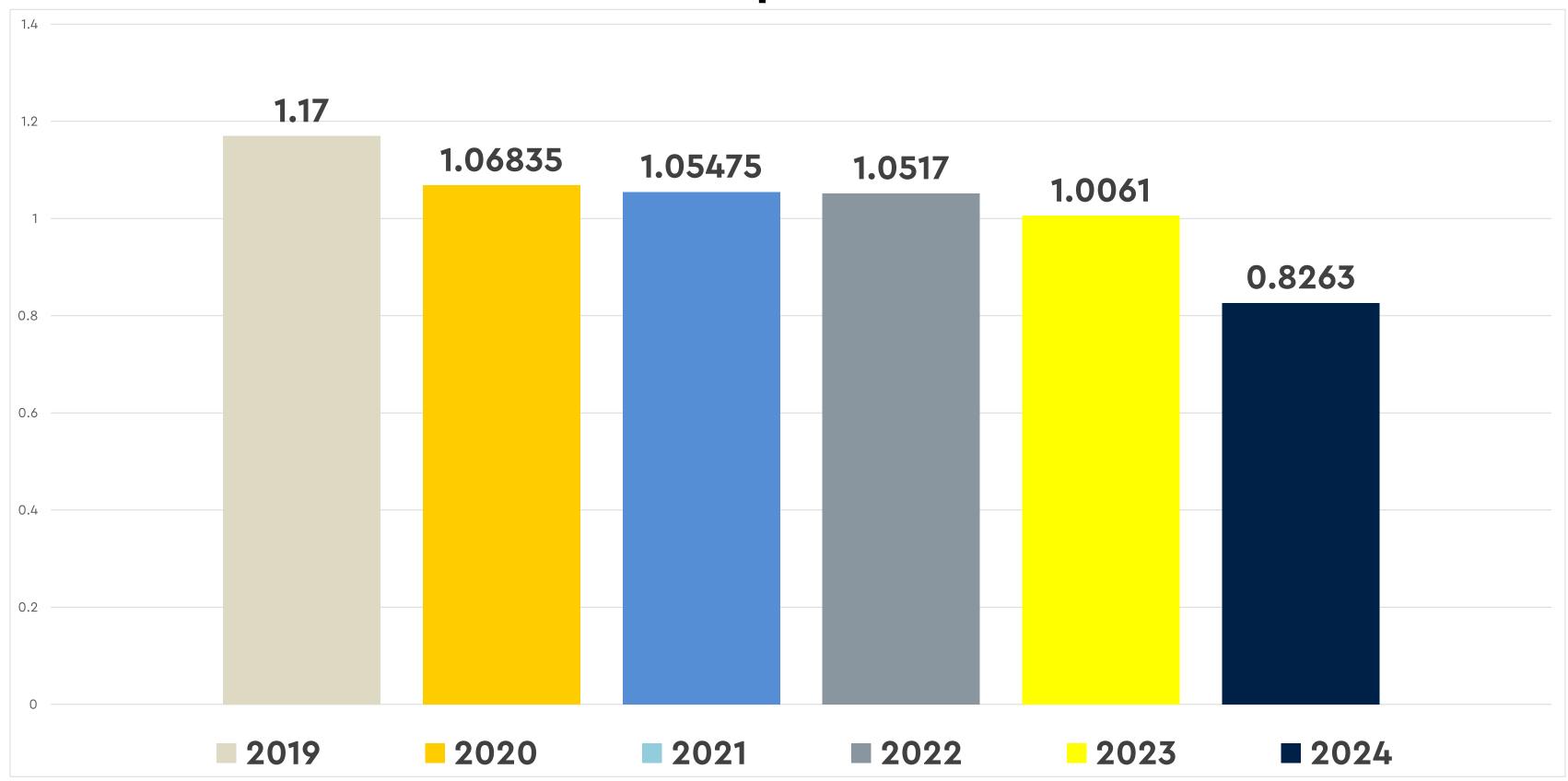

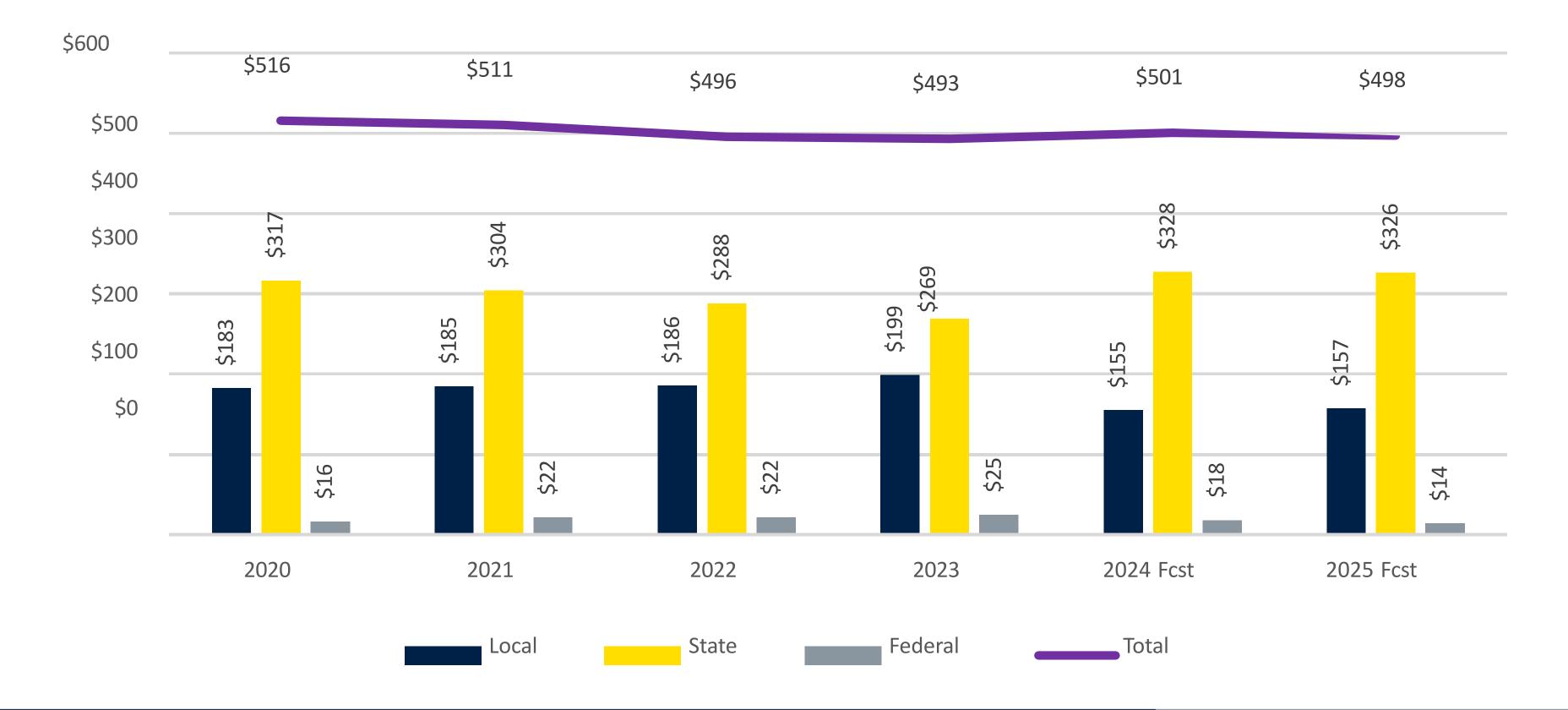

# Annual General Fund Revenue (\$Millions)







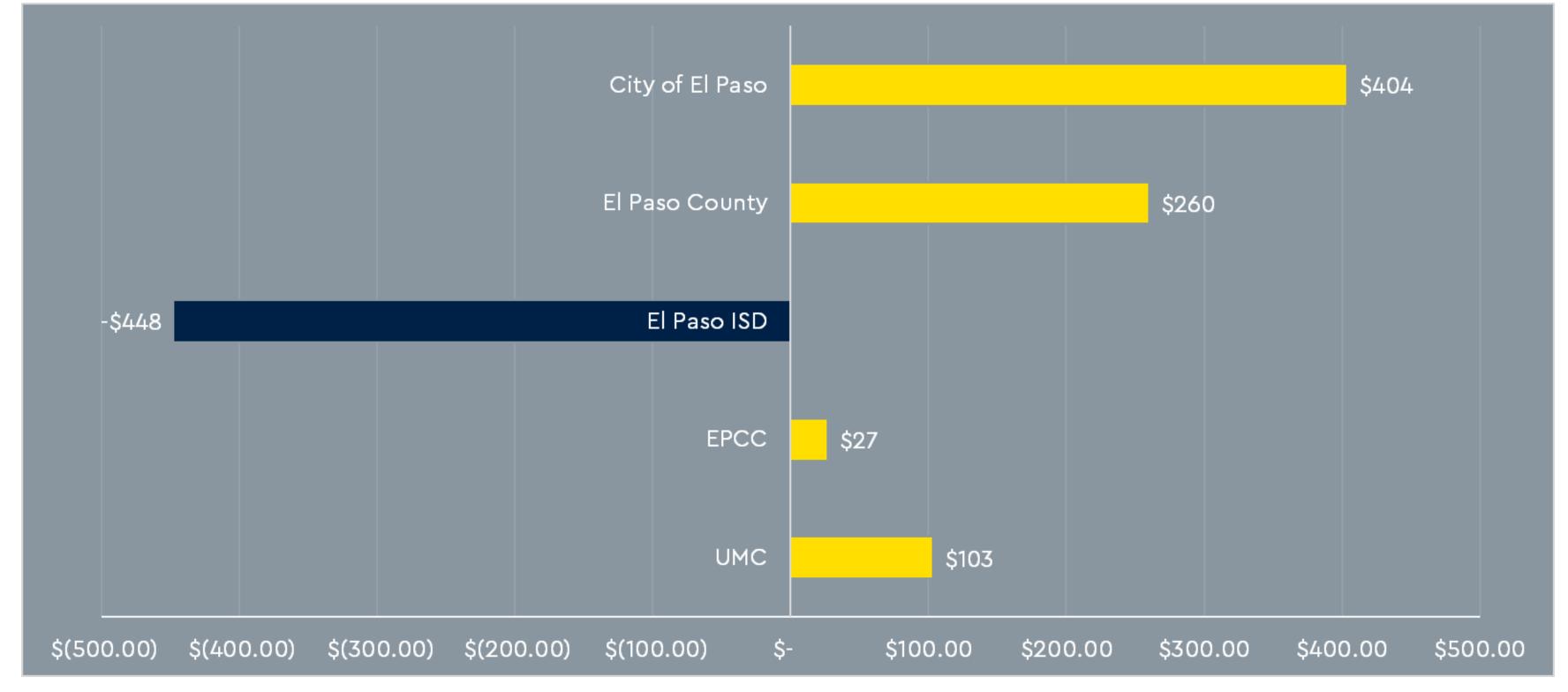

# 5-Year Impact Tax Compression/Homestead Exemption

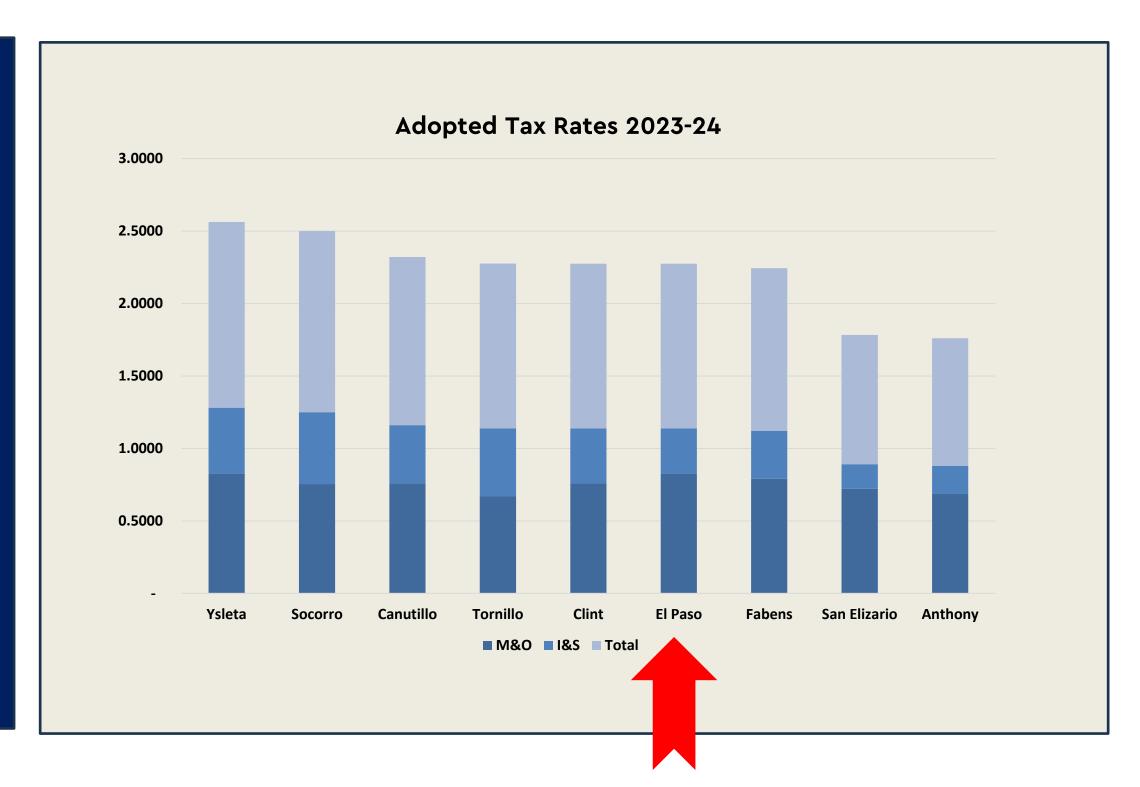


5-Year increase of \$346 in total tax bill of an average value residence within EPISD Boundaries

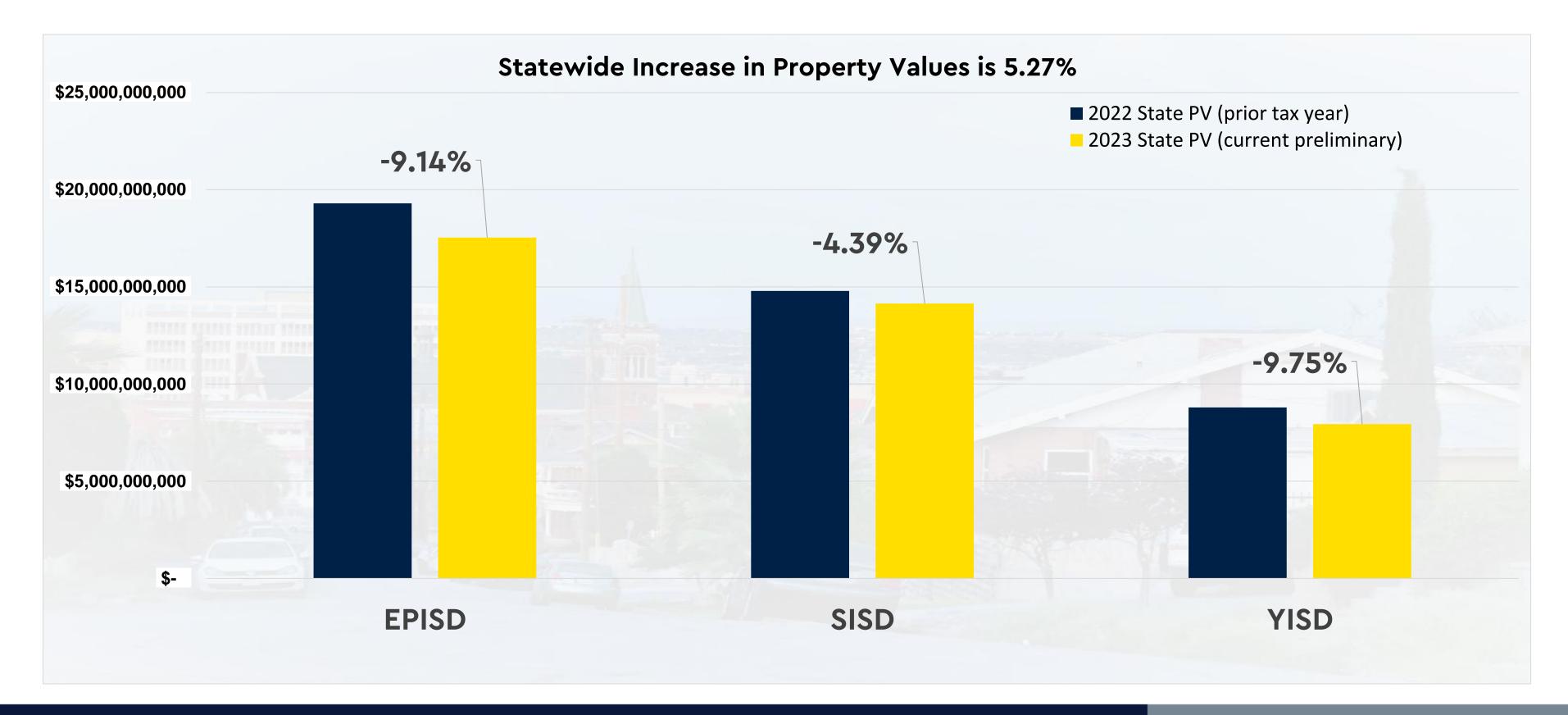

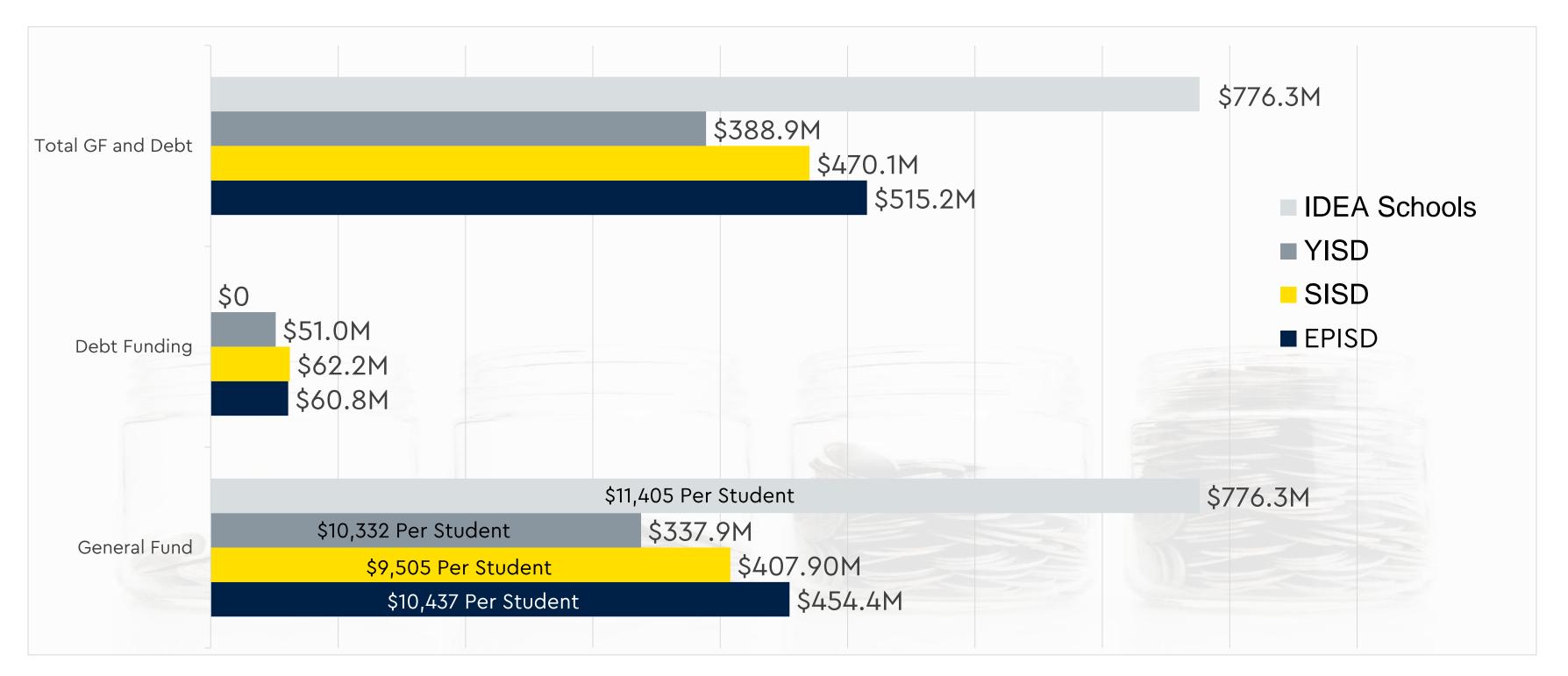


# Regional Change in Property Values (PV)

- The M&O rate is determined by TEA based on property value growth, and the amount of enrichment pennies that have been voter approved.
- The I&S Rate is determined by the District based on property value growth, and the total amount of bonded debt payments due in the following calendar year. The tax rate adopted for 2024-25 will make the debt payments due in February 2025 and August 2025.

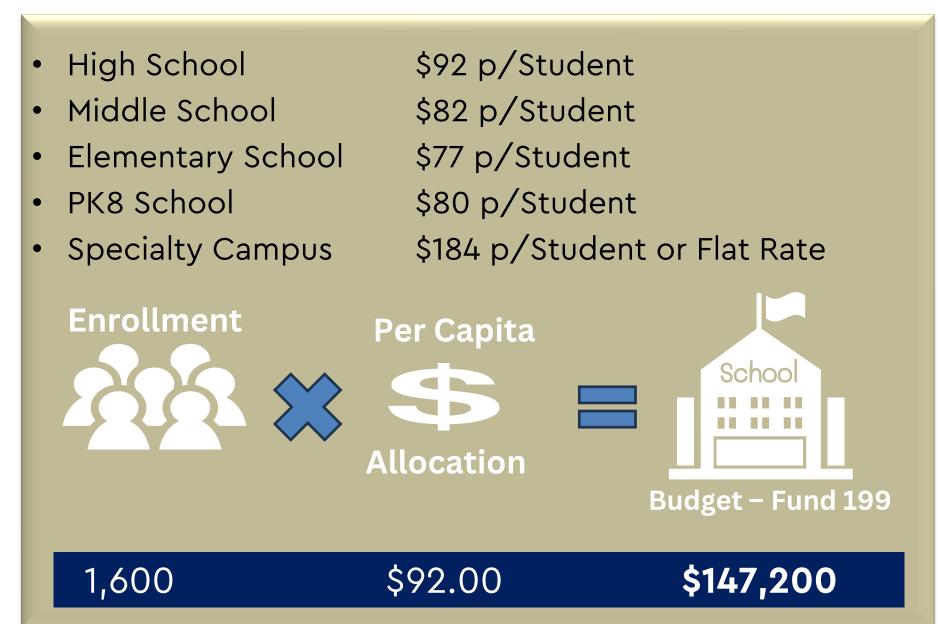

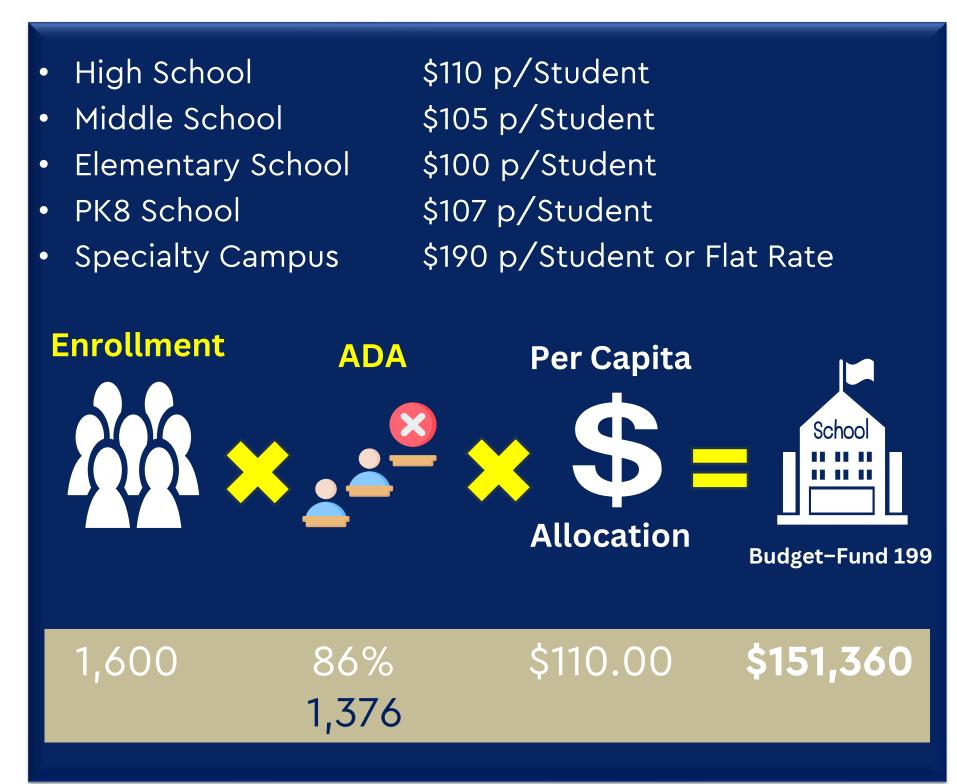
